As a part time resident of Bear Valley, I am very concerned about your plan to limit the terrain that over snow vehicles (OSV) can access in the Stanislaus National Forest. These vehicles do NOT cause damage nor harass wildlife, as the medium to which they travel, aka SNOW, disappears in the spring AND the wildlife in question are hibernating or have migrated to lower terrain.
