Comments: Greetings -

I am both a skier and hiker and have spent considerable time at Lee Canyon in both winter and summer. My comments are as follows:

- * I am in favor of the additional ski lifts, skiing terrain, and certain lodge improvements. The mountain is currently under-utilized for these purposes.

- * In conjunction with the expansion, I would be in favor of some additional mountain biking terrain in the resort area.

- * I am opposed to the mountain coaster. Lee Canyon should be a more natural area and summer activities should be limited to hiking, biking, and horses. The mountain coaster would be disruptive from a visual, noise, and traffic standpoint. For many people in Las Vegas there are basically only two places to hike in summer: Lee Canyon and Kyle Canyon. We can't have 50% of these options impacted by an amusement style ride (and I like roller coasters).

- * In general terms, any resort activity should be limited to the resort area and be kept separated from the existing Bristlecone hiking trail.

- * Some additional parking is a good idea. However I believe that for winter weekends and holidays, there may eventually be a need to restrict traffic into Lee Canyon and utilize a shuttle system from the Sawmill Trailhead parking lot which would serve both Lee Meadows snow play area and Lee Canyon ski resort.
