I also recreate almost every weekend in the winter with my family on GMUG managed lands. Most of the lands currently designated Wilderness areas in the winter are completely inaccessible except by over the snow vehicles that leave no trace of ever being there after the snow melts. Adding additional Wilderness ground would only prove to be a complete mismanagement of GMUG lands, and prove to be a true travesty for the tax paying public that fund the management and stewardship of these public resources.
