Comments: I am a disabled veteran who fought for our country and its values. I lost most of my left leg in Afghanistan. I have a prosthetic limb from 8" below my hip. I only can access the backcountry on a snowmobile or side-by-side tracked vehicles. Hiking is not an option for me.

I would consider any closures and restrictions as a complete insult to the values I fought for and lost friends over. I'm embarrassed by the recent politics in our country and I hope we can learn to live together and work towards goals together. There are some obvious ____-wing nuts on both sides. We should however be able to come up with access maps that allow everyone to enjoy a place in our great American Outdoors.

As a disabled veteran I am severely restricted in my ability to access the great outdoors I love. The national park system is not set up for ADA access. Obviously, areas designated for wilderness areas by default do not allow me to get in there. I can't take a wheelchair into the wilderness, that is illegal. I cannot ride a side-by-side or snowmobile in wilderness, that too is illegal. For you guys to make non-wilderness areas, closed, as if they were wilderness areas should be illegal.
