I live in Palmer Alaska, and have been living in Alaska for over 15 years. I have enjoyed riding snowmachines in the Chugach for 10 years, and I typically go 7-8 times a year. I also enjoy hiking, skiing and other activities. As a motorized user, I oppose losing any right to motorized access of these public lands. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use, and what's left shall remain intact, if not expanded, for future generations.

The areas I access the forest are: Turnagain, Lost Lake, and Johnson Pass

The rights of motorized user groups have diminished since 2002 when The National Forest Service initiated the Forest Land Management Plan and it must stop.
