Comments: First off, thank you for your efforts and willingness to include all user groups in the Chugach Forest Service Revision Plan.

I currently live in Anchorage, and have been living in Alaska for 38 years. I have enjoyed riding snowmachines in the Chugach for 30+ years, and I typically go 10-12 times a year. As a motorized user, I oppose losing any right to motorized access of these public lands. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use, and what's left should remain intact, if not expanded for future generations.

The areas I access the forest are: Johnson Pass, Whittier, Turnagain, Skookum, Lost Lake, Summit Lake, Resurrection Pass

The rights of motorized user groups have diminished since 2002 when The National Forest Service initiated the Forest Land Management Plan and it must stop.

Please consider leaving the current access in place and work toward opening more areas for future generations.
