First off, thank you for your efforts and willingness to include all user groups in the Chugach Forest Service Revision Plan.

I was born and raised in Homer Alaska, I am a fourth generation Alaskan and have enjoyed riding snowmachines in the Chugach for 18 years. I ride there as often as snow allows. The areas in the Chugach are the only mountain riding areas that are less than a 300 mile drive for us in Homer. As a motorized user, I oppose losing any right to motorized access of these public lands. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use, and what's left shall remain intact, if not expanded, for future generations.

The areas I access the forest are: Johnson Pass, Turnagain, Skookum, Lost Lake, Summit Lake

The rights of motorized user groups have diminished since 2002 when The National Forest Service initiated the Forest Land Management Plan and it must stop.

Please consider leaving the current access in place and work toward opening more areas for future generations.
