Comments: Regarding the Forest Service's Draft Land and Resource Management Plan for the Chugach National Forest, ideally, several things should be altered. Firstly, the plan should keep the actual wilderness element and not be diluted by the proposal to keep the "existing character." This should be done by labeling the lands as "primitive," which is the strictest standard for classifying lands and will keep the nature of the place pristine.
