I currently live in Kenai Alaska. I have lived in Alaska for 15 years with 12 of those years being on the Kenai Peninsula. I typically ride Snow machines 10 times a year. As a motorized user I oppose losing any right to motorized access. A large majority of the Chugach is already restricted to non-motorized use and what's left shall remain intact if not expanded for future generations.

The areas I access the forest include Lost Lake, Johnson Pass, Nellie Juan, and Ressurrection Pass, Turnagain, and Summit Lake.

The rights of motorized user groups has diminished since 2002 when the national forest service initiated the Forest Land Management Plan and it must stop.

Please consider leaving the current access plan in place and work toward opening more areas for future generations.
