Comments: In 1905 the USDA Forest Service was established within the Department of Agriculture. The mission was to sustain healthy and diverse forests for present and future generations. The greatest difference between National Parks and forests is that OUR forests are managed for many purposes, such as timber, RECREATION, grazing, wildlife, fish and more whereas National Parks are highly vested in preservation, barely altering the existing state.

With this in mind, any limiting of access into our Nation Forest lands does not meet the intent of which it was created. As it currently sits, Alternative B is the only choice that does not further limit access into CNF lands. I have been recreating inside the CNF since 1979 in both Summer and Winter months. Access has been via ... foot, airplane, snowshoes and snow mobiles. With adequate snow cover, motorized use leaves no trace.

Limiting any kind of access for recreational use inside the CNF is not complying with National Forest guidelines.
