I wanted to write to express my support for expanding the snowmaking capabilities in Vail Mountain.

In addition to the obvious economic benefits to the valley, there are other benefits that may not be as apparent.

I am currently the medical director at ski and snowboard club Vail and an Ambassador for the US ski team. Vail has become the place for early season alpine race training, and athletes from around the world come here in November to train. This brings significant national and international recognition to Vail as a training center of excellence. This trickles down in many intangible ways to improve and enhance the reputation of Vail.
