Comments: There is no need for a new DEIS that lessens any protections. We should be strengthening instead. The current Chugach wilderness should be strongly maintained, and be classified as Primitive in the Forest Service recreational classification system: All ongoing illegal activities in the WSA should be addressed, including better enforcement of all wilderness protections. One such activity is the recreational use of chainsaws in the WSA, which has resulted in damaging tree removal along dozens of wilderness beaches, many in sensitive areas. In summary, as the DEIS is currently written, I support a stronger Alternative D as it is the closest to my recommendations. 'D' should be modified to cover 100% of the WSA, including all lands within the WSA boundary that were acquired for the restoration of wilderness values after the 1989 Exxon Valdez oil spill, and must be perpetually managed for conservation and wilderness purposes.
