Here are a few things I would like to see happen: The plan must protect the "wilderness character" Furthermore, the plan must protect the wilderness character of the lands in the WSA by classifying all of them with the Forest Service's "primitive" standard, which is the most protective standard in the agency's recreational classification system. The Chugach NF must address ongoing illegal recreational use of chainsaws in the WSA, which has resulted in damaging tree removal along dozens of wilderness beaches, including in sensitive areas. Restore strong protection to the lands within the WSA that the federal government purchased following the 1989 Exxon Valdez oil spill.
