Comments: I am writing to oppose amending the management plan (Forest Plan) for the Daniel Boone National Forest. What you are proposing is both short-sighted and completely unnecessary. We are not suffering from a wood product shortage and there remain plenty of private lands available for logging. Your motto is "caring for the land..." Please do this and leave monetizing our resources to others. I urge you to manage the Daniel Boone National Forest as the precious resource it is, and one that should serve generations to come.
