The Pryor Mountains -- as a caver, my first visit there was 1962 -- what a surprise for a gal from Superior Montana -- please do all you can to protect and keep the Wilderness aspects in the Pryors. Its sacredness to the Crow People is extra special!

Manage ALL Recommended Wilderness areas as though they are "real" Wilderness - you can't go back to restore them once mechanized travel has started.

Protect the Crazy Mountains -- the Island Range where it might snow at any time, where you hear rockfall & can't tell where it's coming from -- where the mystery is still in the mountains.

The Lionhead area needs as much protection as possible -- this area seems so remote, but is gaining in popularity & can be easily damaged. It was one of our favorite wild skiing spots.
