I completely agree that these lands should be maintained as the island mountain range that they are and continue to keep them roadless....please!!!

Also these added items are of concern:

- Protecting the following roadless areas in the Pryor Mountains as recommended Wilderness: Lost Water, Big Pryor, Punch Bowl, and Bear Canyon
- Implementing the Gallatin Forest Partnership agreement
- Maintaining the boundaries of the current recommended Wilderness in the Lionhead
- Retain areas currently recommended for Wilderness in the Absaroka Beartooth area, and additionally recommend Dome Mountain, Emigrant Peak, Chico Peak, Woodbine, East Rosebud to Stillwater, and Red Lodge Creek.
- Managing the Tongue River Breaks, King Mountain, and Cook Mountain in the Ashland district as recommended Wilderness
- Managing recommended Wilderness just like designated Wilderness, allowing only foot and horse travel in recommended Wilderness and not allowing any mechanized or motorized use
