I live in Billings, and most of my recent hiking has been in the Beartooth Range. I support maximum areas protected for wilderness that are now under possible wilderness designation consideration. Also please protect Emigrant Peak and Chico Peak, Woodbine and East Rosebud to Stillwater, Dome Mountain, and Red Lodge Creek as wilderness. The Pryor Mountains, a unique area, are in my backyard, and I ask you to protect roadless areas there: Bear Canyon, Big Pryor, Punch Bowl, and Lost Water.

The Crazy Mountains are a day hike distance away from me, and I urge wilderness protection for all the areas in the Crazies being considered for wilderness designation.
