The existing dispersed camping plan for south Taylor Park is working very well and I feel any changes to the dispersed camping Forest Order should be made north of the current boundaries. No changes should be made south of the new Willow Creek bridge/Culvert as it seems to have worked well and there are still plenty of camping spaces available most of the time. I have never seen a time when campers could not find a spot. I believe the current dispersed camping restrictions for south Taylor Park are the most significant and positive Forest Service changes made in the area for a long while. This seems to be the prevailing opinion for nearly all Tin Cup and Rainbow Subdivision residents, tourists, and non-motorized forest users. The current dispersed camping plan provides a much needed buffer zone between careless campers and their campfires, litter, and sanitation issues.
