Comments: The Forest Service has failed to maintain intact boundary fences on the buzzard grazing allotment in the grand Mesa national Forest. One example of this violation is on Owens Creek. Grazing regulations state that intact boundary fences must be up and in place before cattle may be released into the grazing allotments.
