Comments: I have read the Sunnyside Plan of Operations plan and I am in favor of the U.S.F.S. formally approving this application. As proposed in the Sunnyside P.O.O., Barksdale Capital has followed and satisfied all of the required guides to conduct and complete the exploration plan. This includes third-party detailed baseline environmental, wildlife and water studies by third-party and detailed plans to mitigate surface impacts during the proposed drilling and post drilling reclamation and restoration of surface disturbance outlined and discussed, all of which has been reviewed, both in documents provided and follow-up field reviews by the U.S.F.S. personnel.
