I oppose the proposed land swap in the south crazy mountains. While I generally support consolidating public lands to increase access, this proposal trades away already accessible lands of high quality habitat in order to gain sections of lower quality habitat. The USFS should focus on increasing the amount of accessible land, and trading away accessible land does not reach that goal.
