Comments: on page 21; The DEIS states "This EIS and record of decision would follow all legal requirements including appropriate measures per the programmatic agreement." The document should discuss how the Programatic Agreement (PA) will affect the implementaion of the proposed action in greater detail, especially the temporal effects. Measures to "minimizing impacts from motorized use to cultural resources" will take time and money and "may require separate NEPA analysis" as discussed on page 20. Even when funding is available, cultural resource surveys and additional NEPA analysis can take an inordinate amount of time, not to mention required physical protective measures. After the record of decision and cross-country travel is no longer authorized per the existing condition, will compliance with the PA delay (for possibly years) the use of any newly designated dispersed camping corridors or MBGR?
