The website can edit the # of hikers, but I cannot edit it to ZERO or cancel the permit. I do not care about being refunded the \$\$. I feel that this function needs to be added to recreation.gov if this is the intended method for pulling permits. It makes no sense for the permits to be all gone with no ability for the holders to cancel and pass them along to someone else if they cannot attend.
