I think this is important not only to protect old growths without human interference, but birds, animal, insect, worm and other earth populations. Logging with vehicles tears apart a forest and the soft soil underneath, indiscriminately killing whatever is in its way, including plants. Most foresters build roads, cutting down trees, killing birds that may live there, including wildlife that may inhabit the tree itself.

Also, given the number of tribes that depend on this piece of unbroken land, and the history of the United States on double-crossing native American groups, I think this proposal is weighted to favor logging companies and those who want to profit off the land, not those who want to preserve it in any fashion. I would trust the Native American tribes much more than any white man in dealings with land management, because white men have no respect for nature or land, only in how they can profit from it.

I hope after such a long history of stealing tribal land, the government will not do this again, and will respect natives right to live in their historical lands without interference from trucks, roads, chainsaws.
