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Comments: The National Forest Service's plan to build roads in the Tongass National Forest would slash protections for more than 9 million acres of the forest, an area larger than Yellowstone, Glacier and Grand Canyon national parks combined. The Tongass stores more carbon removed from the atmosphere than any other national forest in the country in its old-growth Sitka spruce, hemlock and cedar trees. It helps protect Alaska, which is warming more than twice as fast from climate change as our planet overall. Please do not allow this to happen.

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
