Comments: I would like to object to the Plan Amendments for Pacific Connector Gas Pipeline on the Umpqua, Rogue River-Siskiyou, and Fremont-Winema National Forests. The Forest Service is allowing the profits of a foreign company to take precedence over the property rights and well being of Oregon residents.
