I would like to express a comment in favor of the prairie dog populations in the Thunder Basin National Grasslands. I think these animals need more protections, not less. I would like to see a dramatic decrease in domesticated animal populations; specifically cattle. Cattle are significantly more destructive to the environment than prairie dogs.
