Comments: I object to the Foothills Landscape Project, as the Forest Service is not providing site-specific proposals. Instead, the Forest Service is announcing that somewhere in this massive area it plans to:

Allow for 60,000 acres of commercial timber harvesting;

Conduct prescribed burning on 50,000 acres;

Apply herbicide across up to 74,500 acres (nearly HALF the entire project area!);

Reroute up to 111 miles of trails; and

Build an undisclosed amount of "temporary" roads.

But the Forest Service is not telling the public where any of this will occur.

More specific planning and site information is necessary before proceeding.

Depending upon exactly where these activities will be undertaken, irreversible and devastating damage could occur to invaluable natural resources.
