I am very concerned about the Foothills Landscape Project for the following reasons;

- excludes the public from knowing which areas will be treated with herbicides and logged
- calls for herbicide application on over 65,000 acres
- does not follow USFS mandate of performing an independent assessment of pesticide safety
- massive use of said chemicals does not take into consideration the impact on the soil microbes and fungi that are critical to a healthy forest, not to mention the unique species of invertebrates and vertebrates that live in these natural areas and that depend on these plants
- includes plan to log over 8000 acres of mid to late age oak and pine trees
- excessive thinning of trees in vast areas of our national forests
- building even more roads , thus further fragmenting what is left of our intact forest which will just facilitate the introduction and spread of invasive species and further degrade our streams
