Comments: The initiative to restore proper wildlife habitat to the ground on the National Forests is vital to their continued existence. A depletion of deer and other small creatures doesn't allow for the proper fertilization and distribution of seed and forage. But, the user rights of the land must be preserved throughout, with corresponding opening of WMA's to hunting and camping for each acre of land temporarily suspended from those activities if so required to repair and manage the undergrowth in an area. Absolute right and authority to utilize the public space for recreation, hunting, fishing, and camping should not be infringed on during this process. Special care needs to be taken to not pollute streams from the trout, and salamanders, and other species that lives there during the construction, and a minimal impact approach should be used to do just enough to effect the improvement and not disturb the existing wildlife, bears, etc, which are already there.
