Comments: I do not support the Forest Service's Foothills Landscape Project plan with proposed actions to control:

60,000+ acres of commercial timber harvest

50,000 acres of burning, and construction of 360 miles of new bulldozer paths for burning

Application of herbicides on up to 74,500 acres, at levels that exceed hazard quotients in some scenarios

Use of industrial machinery on up to 83,000 acres for processing vegetation into wood chips

Building an undisclosed amount of "temporary" roads

Rerouting up to 111 miles of trails, and decommissioning trails and dispersed camping areas

No protection for 630 acres of old growth timber in the Chattooga watershed portion of the project.

Long-term detrimental impacts to at least 7,432 acres of soil
