My concern with the foothills project is the lack of information about exactly where and when you will be cutting trees, replanting new species, and burning or spraying areas near our favorite trails. I am concerned that this area, having undergone an extensive clear cut nearly forty years ago, will be torn up once again. What we see as a beautiful example of natural forest succession will be cleared for planting saplings preferred by today's generation of forest managers. This land is a watershed. For that reason I also have concerns about herbicide application. I wonder if you might consider using the natural deterrent of controlled burning for the control of invasive plants?
