I support:

- * CONF efforts to streamline its planning processes and refocus your staff time and funds on the production of goods and services for the public.
- * Alternative 2, the proposed action, over the No Action alternative.
- * Your adaptive management approach to plan implementation.
- * The use of watersheds as the appropriate Project Implementation Areas.
- * Restoration of forest habitat diversity and improving the abundance of fish and wildlife populations, especially early successional species.
- * Active forest management to achieve your fish and wildlife goals. This includes commercial timber harvest, which can provide revenues for road maintenance (and reducestream sedimentation) and wildlife projects.
- * Fuels management to reduce risk of catostrophic wildfire, which is a HUGE risk to coldwater stream ecosystems.
- * Aquatic organism passage.
- * Restoration of channel complexity and aquatic habitat to restore stream fish populations and enhance their resiliency.
- * Road system maintenance to reduce stream sedimentation.
- * More efforts to retrofit small lakes with deep releases, so that warm discharges to downstream trout waters are reduced or eliminated.
- * Enhancing recreational opportunities on lakes and streams, with your budget constraints. Partnership opportunities abound here.
