The Foothills Landscape Project includes parts of 8 North Georgia Counties and the Cohutta WMA National Forest lands. According to United States Census Bureau and State of Georgia population and migration projections many of these counties will see the largest percentage population increases in Georgia in the next 10 to 20 years and beyond.

I am concerned that the NEPA process is being marginalized. The Forest Service is refusing to identify specific places they intend to cut trees, apply herbicides, start fires and build roads.
