These trails are highly used by mountain bikers and horseback riders to avoid traveling along the gravel or paved roads. These trails allow for a 25 mile all-trail Bull-Jake loop which is very popular. Jones Creek Dam has just been rerouted - why would you propose to decommission a trail that was just realigned? Many horses and bike riders park at the Jake Mountain lot (including myself) and always use the connector trail to get down to FS 28-1. Several large events use these trails, which brings in people from all over the US. The Fools Gold Bike Race uses all these trails and has 400+ riders that come to Georgia specifically to ride these trails. These trails are also part of an IMBA epic ride loop. These trails are all used for ingress/egress to the Bull Mountain loop by many riders by those who'd rather not drive all the way to the Bull Mtn parking lot. Please do not decommission these trails.
