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Comments: I have voiced the opinion in many forums and in response to the EIS FOR THE Jordan Cove/ 0-civic Connector Pipeline that the damage done by clear cutting paths through a large part of the state would result in decreased water quality, fire hazard, increased land and rockslides and irreparable harm to multiple watersheds. Eel, salmon, steelhead, sturgeon, cutthroat, sand shrimp and other species will be directly and adversely affected.

Long term economic damage will result as well.

Associated use of chemical applications of herbicides to maintain these pathways/right of ways will result in permanent damage to wildlife and human life including permanent epigenetic damage to DNA of all species.
