I am concerned that flooding which came with Hurricane Harvey would flood the slurry pits associated with the drilling as well as the wells, themselves. The lake went to 206.35 MSL and can go to 207 MSL, then add another 3 feet for waves, 210 MSL. Added to that there was concern that the Lewis Creek Reservoir Dam that was leaking might give way with all the rain and add another 3 feet of water surge, 213 MSL. My concern in a nut shell is if they can not protect the slurry pits and wells from a surge lake level of 215 MSL the lake is at risk. This does not even cover the wildlife displacement, noise and air pollution.
