This project appears to be proceeding as usual for fire danger mitigation projects elsewhere in Colorado, i.e. thinning and pile burning as major components. While the end of reducing the danger of conflagrations is a good one, the FS needs to pay more attention to reducing CO2 emissions, or soil carbon loss into these kinds of projects.
