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Comments: We understand the basic principles of forest management that have led to this massive project. We are concerned about the possibility of a catastrophic fire in the Bead Lake area. We are somewhat amused by the new euphemisms that are being used to justify timber harvest to pay for all the good things described in the plan description. We were startled to see the large chart on the wall (which was not reproduced and sent to us in any of the mailings or at the meeting we attended) in which the entire bowl of Bead Lake is designated as "Commercial." Shades of the 1984-ish BJ Timber Sale! We dread having to look at the temporary roads necessary for harvesting the timber and removal of ladder vegetation. We are very skeptical of the statement that bench roads would not be used and that some other type of road building would be used to eliminate bulldozed material from cascading down-slope. We are in favor of extending the Bead Lake trail to the No Name Lake area. We agree that a dock is needed for safety at the boat launch. As an aside, we cannot help but think that the irreversible milfoil infestation is an unintended consequence of the launching of un-examined boats at the launch. We also wonder what will be the unintended (negative!) consequences of this well-intentioned and arguably necessary project.
