I WAS VERY HAPPY TO HEAR ABOUT THE PUBLICS ABILITY TO SEND IN POSTS OR COMMENTS ON THE CURRENT BUZZ OF THE HEBER "WILD" HORSE PORBLEM. THESE SO CALLED "WILD HORSES" ARENT NATIVE TO THE MOGOLLON RIM AREAS. MOST OF THESE HORSES ARE RESERVATION HORSES CROSSING OVER AFTER THE RODEO CHEDISKY FIRE IN I BELIEVE THE YEAR WAS 2002. BURNT PINE TREES AND OTHER DEBRIS FROM THE FIRE CAUSING WIRED FENCES TO BE BROKEN ALLOWING THESE FERAL RESERVATION HORSES TO CROSS OVER AND GRAZE AND ROAM FREE. THEIR OWNERS DINT WANT THEM AND THEY HAVE MADE NO ATTEMPT RECOVER HORSES LEFT FOR DEAD ON THE FIRST PLACE ALL THOSE YEARS AGO.

I WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE PLANS AND OPINIONS OF LOCAL RANCHERS AND FARMERS AND MULTI GENERATIONAL FAMILIES FROM HEBER TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER THESE OTHER OUTSIDE OPINIONS FROM OTHER STATES AND COMMUNITIES.

WE SHOULD REGULATE THE HORSES WE HAVE NOW BEFORE ALLOWING THEM TO GROW AND BECOME TOO NUMEROUS TO CONTROL.
