None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

The Great Burn is one of the largest roadless areas left in our country. It is a treasure and needs to be left alone for our children, our grandchildren, and generations to come. Removing protections from the Great Burn and allowing motorized vehicles will ruin this magnificent treasure. Please maintain the status of recommended wilderness. Thank you!

I have hiked through many areas of the Great Burn and have found peace in the quiet and wildness. I have sat and watched the mountain goats grazing on the hillside and seen hawks soaring in the sky. I have nibbled my way down hillsides plump with huckleberries. Please preserve this wonderful place.
