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Comments: The Tonto National Forest is home to 19 threatened and endangered species, and 50 species of conservation concern. It is outrageous that the Forest Service under the Trump administration favors grazing, mining, logging and motorized recreation to the detriment of numerous fish and wildlife species. Inventoried Roadless Areas and even the few places recommended for wilderness protection will be vulnerable to off-road vehicles.

Please do what is right for the area, the environment and wildlife by:

Designating all Inventoried Roadless Areas as non-motorized, manage recommended wilderness as true wilderness in order to preserve their changes for future designation, include an objective that removes all unnecessary roads over the life of the forest plan and establish standards that truly protects fish and wildlife, and restores and connect their habitat. Doing these would be a move in the right direction and one that will help protect the area as best as possible
