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Comments: The Tonto National Forest is home to 19 threatened and endangered species, and 50 species of conservation concern. Under the current administration, all kinds of recreation, as well as mining, logging, and grazing is allowed, much to the detriment of both the wilderness and the wild animals who live there.

This should NOT be allowed to continue, and action must be taken to protect ALL the national forests in the USA. Farmers should NOT be allowed to graze (and kill the animals that live there), companies should not be allowed to mine and log the wilderness and forests, and motorized vehicles of ANY kind shouldn't be allowed to wreck the landscape and areas.

The Tonto National Forest should be granted the strongest protections possible.

- 1) All "Roadless" areas should be non-motorized; as the use of motorized vehicles quickly make 'roads' in the wilderness, and it becomes the norm.
  - 2) Please manage Recommended Wilderness as TRUE wilderness in order to preserve their changes for future designation;
  - 3) An objective should be included that that removes all unnecessary roads over the life of the forest plan.
  - 4) Standards should be established that truly protect fish and wildlife, and restores and connects their habitat.
