Comments: I understand that recreation is an equally significant component of Forest Management as is grazing, as mandated by the MUSYA of 1960. There should be no further expansion of dispersed recreation without a plan in place to hold accountable those who would dump trash, potentially start fires, and degrade rangelands with motorized recreation vehicles going off designated roads. Also, as visitors increase, before any further campsites are considered on legally permitted grazing allotments, the FS should consult with the permittee as to which areas are least likely to disrupt their economic operations.
