Allow NO REMOVAL of any wild horse by the Forest Service without LEGAL PROOF that the horse is "excess."

Setting an ARBITRARY number of 104 wild horses is ILLEGAL and OUT OF COMPLIANCE with the definition of "excess." The Forest Service MAY NOT DETERMINE arbitrary numbers of horses in the territory.

Do NOT ALLOW use of birth control (PZP). COMPLY with LEGAL MANDATES of "minimal feasible management." The PZP endocrine disrupter causes PERMANENT sterility within FOUR YEARS - not seven as stated by the drug producers. PZP is HIGHLY INTRUSIVE and NOT LEGALLY COMPLIANT management.
