Comments: I have recently reviewed the released Nez Perce-Clearwater Forest Plan Revision Draft Environmental Impact Statement and Draft Revised Forest Plan. None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

As someone who lives adjacent to Forest Service land I have a first hand view of the ways in which motorized vehicles street our wildlife and wild environment. Noise and woodland destruction is damaging to the deer, elk, and important predators as well as the smaller species that sustain them and the forest floor. Motorized vehicles are unnecessary to the enjoyment of the wilderness. A walk in the woods is far more enlightening and comforting.

Although I have not visited the great burn I daily enjoy the forest that I live in.

I agree that the entire area continue to be managed for all of us, as recommended wilderness.

Motorized access serves a few thrill seekers rather than then the majority of us who prefer the regenerative stillness of our forest environment.
