Comments: I have recently reviewed the released Nez Perce-Clearwater Forest Plan Revision Draft Environmental Impact Statement and Draft Revised Forest Plan. None of the alternatives presented reflect the management I would like to see implemented for the Hoodoo Roadless Area. Please accept these comments into the formal record.

I have deep concerns about motorized access into the roadless area, especially with regard to impact on the land and the species that live there (e.g. Mountain Goats.)

Hiking in the Great Burn has been a delight, having done so spring-autumn. It is a spectacular area with clear, high mountain lakes, stunning large old growth trees, and a variety of birds and plants to enjoy.

I absolutely would like to see the entire Hoodoo Roadless Area be managed as Recommended Wilderness.

The impact to the land and species within the Hoodoo Roadless Area would be impacted by winter motorized access. In particular, it would disturb the habitat for Mountain Goats. It would take away the 'Roadless' in the area.

I am all for Cayuse Creek and Kelly Creek being recognized as Wild and Scenic.
