Further, the Forest Service should continue to protect the entire 151,874-acre Hoodoo Roadless Area as Recommended Wilderness in the revised forest plan. Only the Clearwater portion of the Forest currently has a winter travel plan. The revised forest plan should include a commitment to begin winter travel planning within three years on the Nez Perce portion of the forest, including the Moose Creek, Salmon River, and Red River Ranger Districts.
