We have been enjoying the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forest for years now. We enjoy camping and riding our ATV's responsibly through the forest system. We fish the salmon, Selway and Lochsa River at least 3 times a year as we love the beauty of the forest system in this area as well as the fishing the rivers hold. We have camped and rode our atv's in many of the areas the proposed DEIS proposes except Alternative X. This is the only alternative that provides for increased opportunities for motorized recreation in the semi primitive areas of the forest. This forest ought to follow the lead of what the locals want. Alternative X also excludes any RWA and any new WRS. It provides for increased summer motorized use opportunities (which our family does almost every weekend of the year), particularly by encouraging loop opportunities and protects snowmobile use in the Great Burn.
