Closing areas such as the Nez Perce- Clearwater NF would greatly limit my access, as well as that of other disabled peoples, veterans and non-veterans alike. Tax payers. Enthusiasts. I belong to a large ATV club. We spend countless hours each year conducting community service work and camps and cleanup efforts around the local area. We also donate thousands of dollars to local charities every year. The amount of revenue our club alone adds to the local economy is likely in the millions of dollars. I strongly prefer Alternative X as described in the DEIS. This is the only alternative that provides for increased opportunities for motorized recreation in the semi primitive areas of the Forest. This alternative is consistent with state and local preferences. The Forest ought to follow the lead of what the locals want. Importantly, Alternative X also excludes any RWA and any new WRS. It provides for increased summer motorized use opportunities, particularly by encouraging loop opportunities, and protects snowmobile use in the Great Burn.
